

RESOLUTION NO. R- 4 -2026

A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH,
AUTHORIZING EXTENDED HOURS FOR CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS
FOR THE 4MG SCARLET RIDGE WATER TANK, AS ALLOWED IN
EAGLE MOUNTAIN MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 8.15.080(G)

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Eagle Mountain Municipal Code Section 8.15.080(G) states that the City Council may authorize extended hours for construction operations or procedures which, by their nature, require continuous operation, or modify or waive the hours of work for or on projects in generally isolated areas where the extended hours do not impact upon adjoining property occupants; and

WHEREAS, Pro Build Construction has requested authorization from the City Council to conduct certain construction activities after midnight and continuing through the night and into the following workday; and

WHEREAS, the overnight work consists of intermittent concrete pours occurring over the next six months, for construction of The Scarlet Ridge 4MG Water Tank Project located east of the Scarlet Ridge subdivision and the John Hancock Charter School on the south end of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, finds it is in the public interest to authorize extended construction hours for intermittent concrete pours subject to review and approval by the Public Works and Engineering Departments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah:

1. Extended hours for construction operations related to the Scarlet Ridge 4MG Water Tank Project are hereby authorized, subject to review and approval by the Public Works and Engineering Departments.
2. This Resolution shall take effect upon its first publication or posting.
