

RESOLUTION NO. R-28 -2025

A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH,  
EXPRESSING AN INTENT TO WORK IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE  
WEST TRAVERSE SENTINEL LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE  
FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY RODEO GROUNDS  
WITHIN THE ARMY COMPATIBLE USE BUFFER (ACUB) AREA  
SURROUNDING CAMP WILLIAMS

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Eagle Mountain City (the “City”) is a political subdivision of the State of Utah, and the Council of Eagle Mountain City (the “Council”) is a public entity with the authority to make resolutions with respect to the City; and

WHEREAS, the West Traverse Sentinel Landscape (the “WTSL”) Act (Utah Code Chapter § 39A-8) formed the WTSL Committee to protect critical lands adjacent to Camp Williams with a mission to establish mutual goals and trusted relationship with surrounding communities that prudently balance the military training needs of Camp Williams with conservation and compatible economic interests within the designated sentinel land scape area; and

WHEREAS, The WTSL stated Goals are to:

- *Protect the training mission at Camp Williams in perpetuity,*
- *Partner with local communities to create partnerships, reliance, and compatibility,*
- *Enhance quality of life initiatives in newly created open space,*
- *Be proactive in protecting wildlife migration corridors and habitat; and*


WHEREAS, The City desires to work in partnership with the WTSL to plan for the eventual relocation of the City’s Rodeo Grounds, and plan for other compatible public recreation and quality of life initiatives, to be constructed within the Army Compatible Use Buffer (ACUB) areas surrounding Camp Williams that would support the goals and objectives of the WTSL.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah:


1. That the Council hereby expresses its intent and desire to work in partnership with the WTSL to plan for the eventual relocation of the City's Rodeo Grounds, and plan for other compatible public recreation and quality of life initiatives within the ACUB; and
2. Invites the WTSL to work in partnership with the City to designate and approve a site or sites within the ACUB for these compatible uses, all in accordance with Utah Code Annotated § 39A-8-104 et. Seq.
