

RESOLUTION NO. R-52-2025

A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SIGNIFICANT CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO EAGLE MOUNTAIN MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 3.30

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah is a public body with the authority to dispose of real property pursuant to the Eagle Mountain Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, EMMC 3.30.060 provides the process for the disposal of significant real property, including a requirement for public notice, a public hearing, and evaluation by City staff and departments; and

WHEREAS, the City has received an application to dispose of parcel 59:044:0015, 2.15 acres, in exchange for the City taking possession of Parcel A, 2.32 acres, in the Marketplace at Eagle Mountain Town Center Preliminary Plat, Phase 4; and

WHEREAS, the exchange of property is identified in The Marketplace at Eagle Mountain Town Center Development Agreement, Paragraph 6, and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the application and recommends the disposal; and

WHEREAS, all public notice requirements under EMMC 3.30.060 have been met, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on this matter and finds it in the best interest of the City and community to dispose of the Subject Property under the terms described below.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the disposal of parcel 59:044:0015, 2.15 acres, in exchange for the City taking possession of Parcel A, 2.32 acres, in the Marketplace at Eagle Mountain Town Center Preliminary Plat, Phase 4, as presented by City staff, as determined and approved by Council and depicted in Exhibit A.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passing.

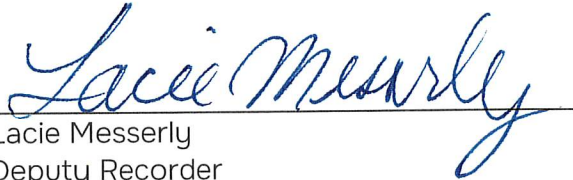
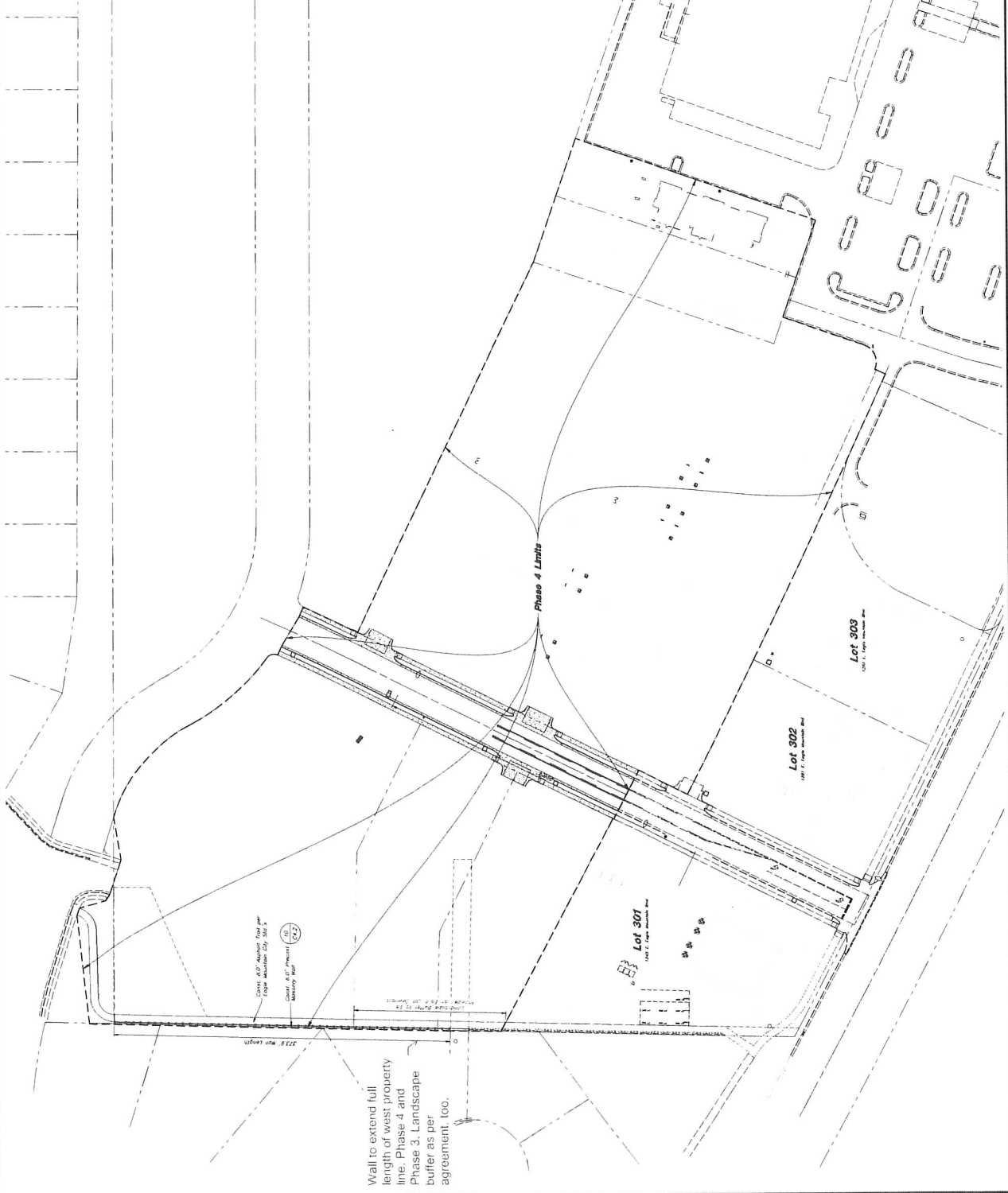
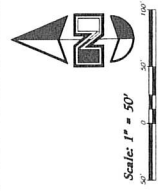

The Contractor agrees that he shall assume and complete responsibility for job site conditions during the course of construction at this project, including safety of persons and property that the requirement shall apply continuously and not be limited to normal working hours, and that the contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold the owner and the engineering firm harmless for any liability arising from the engineering connection with the performance of work on this project, excepting for liability arising from the sole negligence of the owner or the engineer.

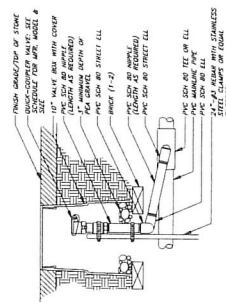
STOP & WASTE VALVE



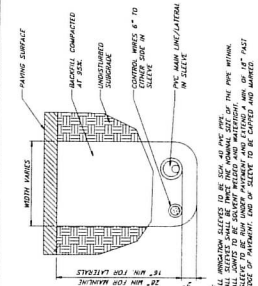
REMOTE CONTROL VALVE



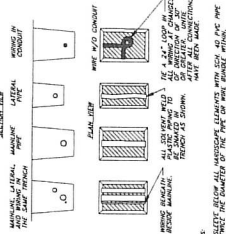
MANUAL DRAIN VALVE



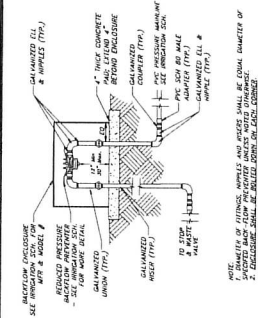

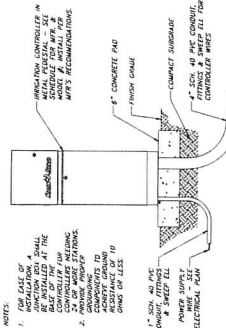

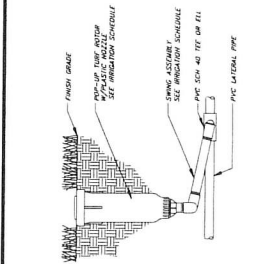
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
