

RESOLUTION NO. R-81 -2025

A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE TRAFFIC CONTROL AND ROAD CLOSURE PERMIT AUTHORIZED UNDER EMMC 15.10.280

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City is empowered by law to adopt resolutions establishing fees for municipal services and has established an equitable system of fees for providing municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted an ordinance amending EMMC 15.10.280 to establish a Traffic Control and Road Closure Permit for construction activities occurring within the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, a corresponding fee structure is necessary to support the administration of the permit, ensure proper review of traffic control plans, and promote compliance with City standards; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish permit fees consistent with the duration and impacts of such activities and aligned with practices used by other Utah municipalities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah:

1. The Traffic Control and Road Closure Permit fees are hereby adopted as set forth in Exhibit A, incorporated herein by reference.
2. These fees shall be included in the Eagle Mountain City Consolidated Fee Schedule and shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
3. This Resolution is not intended to repeal, abrogate, annul, or in any way impair or interfere with existing provisions of other resolutions, ordinances, or laws except to effect modification of the fees reflected in the Consolidated Fee Schedule. The fees listed in the Consolidated Fee Schedule supersede present fees for services specified, but all fees not listed remain in effect. Where this Resolution imposes a higher fee than is imposed or required by existing provisions, resolution, ordinance, or law, the provisions of this resolution shall control.
4. The City Recorder is directed to update the published fee schedule accordingly.
