

RESOLUTION NO. R-10 -2024

**A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH,
APPROVING THE DECISION-MAKING PROCESS AND
SPECIFIC PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED WITH THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS**

PREAMBLE

The City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, finds that it is in the public interest to approve the decision-making process and specific projects to be completed with the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah:

1. The City Council selects Option 2 from Mountainland Association of Governments (MAG) "Summary of Option for Funding CDBG" for year 1 of its eligibility as set forth in Exhibit A.
2. The City Council desires to allocate the CDBG funds in the following manner:
 - \$120,000 for a new senior bus;
 - \$50,000 for an additional senior center building;
 - \$30,000 for a utility assistance program;
3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.


