

RESOLUTION NO. R-15 -2025

**A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH, SUPPORTING THE
CREATION OF A UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY PROJECT AREA WITHIN
EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY TO INITIATE FURTHER ANALYSIS OF ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Eagle Mountain City is committed to fostering economic development and exploring opportunities that enhance infrastructure, investment, and job creation; and

WHEREAS, the Utah Inland Port Authority (UIPA) facilitates economic growth through the development of strategic logistics and trade hubs; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution does not create a UIPA Project Area but expresses the City's support for initiating further analysis into potential locations, uses, and economic benefits of such an area within Eagle Mountain City; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution enables UIPA to conduct a deeper analysis and coordinate with City staff and elected officials to assess areas that may be included in one or more project areas, as well as establish goals, parameters, and potential benefits; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution also allows Eagle Mountain City to collaborate with Fairfield and Cedar Fort on a larger regional inland port framework should cooperative opportunities arise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, as follows:

1. The City Council supports the exploration of a Utah Inland Port Authority Project Area within Eagle Mountain City.
2. This Resolution does not create a UIPA Project Area but authorizes UIPA to conduct further analysis and coordinate with City staff and elected officials on potential locations, objectives, and feasibility.
3. The City Council supports regional collaboration with Fairfield and Cedar Fort on a broader inland port framework should mutual benefits be identified.
4. City staff are directed to engage with UIPA and other relevant entities in this assessment and planning process.

5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
