The Eagle Mountain City Council will hold public hearings on **April 7, 2026, at 7:00 PM** or as soon thereafter as business allows, in the Eagle Mountain City Council Chambers, 1650 E Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, Utah 84005. The City Council will receive public comments concerning the following items:

Parks, Trails and Open Space Master Plan:

- Eagle Mountain has contracted with MHTN to update the Parks, Trails and Open Space Plan. This effort includes a comprehensive inventory of the City's existing parks and recreational assets, an evaluation of current conditions, and an analysis of level of service to identify gaps and opportunities. The plan also outlines strategic recommendations to guide parks development and improvements over the next several years, including project prioritization based on community needs, service equity, and long-term buildout. *EMC Point of Contact: Assistant Public Works Director, Zac Hilton: zhilton@eaglemountain.gov.*
