NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Eagle Mountain City Council will hold public hearings on **June 16, 2026, at 7:00 PM** or as soon thereafter as business allows, in the Eagle Mountain City Council Chambers, 1650 E Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, Utah 84005. The City Council will receive public comments concerning the following items:

FY 2026-2027 Interim Budget Adoption:

- **FY 2026-2027 Interim Budget Adoption:** Eagle Mountain City will hold a Public Hearing at 7:00 PM, on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, to accept public comment on the 2026-2027 fiscal year Interim Budget. The Public Hearing will be held at the Eagle Mountain City Municipal Building located at 1650 E Stagecoach Run, Eagle Mountain, in the City Council Chambers. Public comment is welcome. The proposed budget can be viewed at eaglemountain.gov/finance and in the office of the Eagle Mountain City Recorder.

The Interim Budget will be in effect for the period beginning on July 1, 2026, and ending after August 18, 2026, upon the City Council's adoption of a final budget. The fiscal year 2026-2027 tentative budget presented to the City Council on May 5, 2026, proposes a property tax increase triggering the Truth-In-Taxation process. The Interim Budget sets aside, in a restricted budget account the additional property tax revenue generated by the proposed tax rate increase. The City may not expend or otherwise obligate the restricted revenue until the completion of the Truth-In-Taxation process and the City Council has taken action to adopt a final budget for fiscal year 2026-2027 subject to the requirements of Utah Code Section 52-2-919.
